


## Sentence practice (3)

### Exercise 1

Translate these sentence groups. The first one has been done to show you how.

1. amamus. We love.

equum amamus. We love the horse.

2. cantas. You sing.

male cantas. You sing badly.

3. video. I see.

stellas video. I see the stars.

4. audimus. We hear.

sonum audimus. We hear the sound.

### Exercise 2

On these following Latin sentences, mark the verb, then work out whether the other word is a subject noun (doing the action), object noun (having the action done to it) or an adverb. Then use this information to help you translate the sentence. The first one has been done to show you how.

1. <sup>subject</sup> magae <sup>verb</sup> cantant. The witches sing.

2. <sup>subject</sup> reginae <sup>verb</sup> laborant. The queens work.

3. <sup>object</sup> tabernas <sup>verb</sup> videmus. We see the shops.

4. <sup>adverb</sup> celeriter <sup>verb</sup> numerant. They count quickly.

5. <sup>object</sup> sonos <sup>verb</sup> auditis. Y'all hear the sounds.

### Exercise 3

On these following Latin sentences, mark the verb, then look for a subject, and then an object. Finally, work out what kind of word is left. Use this information to help you translate the sentence. The first one has been done to show you how.

1. <sup>subject</sup> medicus <sup>adverb</sup> male <sup>object</sup> equum <sup>verb</sup> curat. The doctor looks after the horse badly.

2. <sup>subject</sup> maga <sup>object</sup> hortum <sup>adverb</sup> bene <sup>verb</sup> curat. The witch looks after the garden well.

3. <sup>subject</sup> medici <sup>adverb</sup> irate <sup>object</sup> vaccas <sup>verb</sup> audiunt. The doctors angrily hear the cows.

4. <sup>subject</sup> reginae <sup>adverb</sup> celeriter <sup>object</sup> magos <sup>verb</sup> numerant. The queens quickly count the wizards.

5. <sup>subject</sup> porcus <sup>adverb</sup> fortiter <sup>object</sup> equum <sup>verb</sup> salutat. The pig bravely greets the horse.
