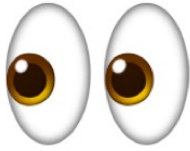


Latin verb endings

Can you sort these Latin verbs into the right boxes depending on their endings and then say what they mean? One has been done to show you how. The two verbs we will use are:



videre, to see

and



laborare, to work

videt **t** vides **s** ~~laboramus~~ **us** laborat **t** laboratis **is**
laboras **s** laborant **nt** video **o** videmus **us** vident **nt**
videtis **is** laboro **o**

ending in -o (I)

laboro I work

video I see

ending in -mus (we)

laboramus we work

videmus we see

ending in -s (you)

laboras you work

vides you see

ending in -tis (y'all)

laboratis y'all work

videtis y'all see

ending in -t (he, she, it)

laborat he, she, it works

videt he, she, it sees

ending in -nt (they)

laborant they work

vident they see
