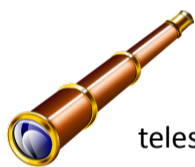




ENGLISH - ANCIENT GREEK WORD MATCH-UP

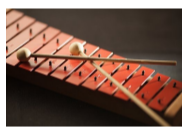
Many English words have their roots in Ancient Greek. Can you match these English words to their Ancient Greek ancestors? The first one has been done to show you how.

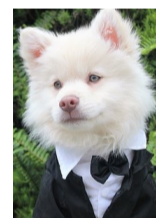

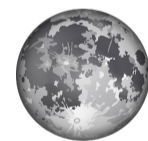

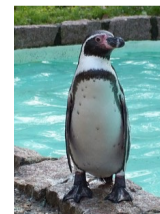
